General Information

- This event is conducted under SRA rules.
- At the Safety Scrutineering, competitors' passes will be given for entry into the event on the weekend. **A fee will be charged at the gate to enter the start / finish area on the weekend, if no competitor passes are presented.**
- There will be food and first aid available at the turnaround area. If first aid is required, please contact a SES person, for assistance.
- **There is to be no refuelling at the turnaround area, or between events in the Caravan Park.** Please carry enough fuel in the boat, to complete the race. **NO REFUELLING IN THE WATER.**
- A committee of Ski Racing Victoria will seed all classes in the interests of safety as per rules of SRA.
- Notification of race numbers will be by e-mail or mail. Competitors are to supply their own numbers in accordance with SRA rules.
- Teams are welcome to send a one (1) page resume of current race achievements with entry form for publicity purposes.
- **All boats** are to complete a race day report sheet at the end of **each day** of racing or face \$200 fine and possible non acceptance of the 2010 event.
- **Drivers and Observers** will need to attend and sign in at Briefing. The Briefing will take place at the Robinvale Community Centre at **6pm** on **Friday 5th March 2010. Doors close at 6.15pm – no entry after this.**
- Any practice on the river will be before the weekend of racing, and normal maritime laws will apply.

- All competitors and officials will be Breathalysers each day prior to the official 9:00am start as per SRA rules.

Dash for Cash/Invitational 2010

- The Dash for Cash will have up to 40 competitors in it - consisting of 15 Superclass boats and 25 others.
- Superclass will be run under SRA rules. Any boat entering Superclass must also nominate another class. Note: not all boats nominated for Superclass will be accepted.
- The finishing order of the Dash of Cash will determine the start order for Sunday.
- Any Superclass boat failing to finish will start immediately behind the last finishing Superclass boat.
- Any boat wishing to nominate for the 25 other positions in the Dash for Cash may do so by nominating, paying \$130 with their entry and providing a one page resume of their teams accomplishments, prior to being considered for a position in the Dash for Cash. Only complete genuine teams to apply.
- A decision will be made by the SRV committee regarding allocation of the 25 remaining positions. No correspondence will be entered into. If you are unsuccessful in your nomination your money will be refunded.
- Cost of entry into the Dash for Cash is \$130
- Prize Money for the Dash for Cash is
 - 1st Place - \$1000
 - 2nd Place - \$500
 - 3rd Place - \$300

Junior Dash

A Junior Dash will operate on the Saturday, following the Senior Social class and will involve teams of junior skiers (under 16 years) competing on the Dash for Cash course. This is a separate event and as such the team does not have to be the same as that competing in the Sunday event. Cost to enter is \$130

The number of entries in the Junior Dash is limited to 10. Selection is at the discretion of the SRV Committee. If you are unsuccessful in your nomination your money will be refunded.

Boats will be selected that require safety scrutineered on Friday 5th **March 2010** from **10am – 4pm**.

Venue: McLennan Drive (along banks of river)

If you are unable to attend scrutineering at this time. It your responsibility to contact the Chief Scrutineer Andrew Donahue to arrange an alternative time and venue.

After the completion of racing, all engine classes will be required for post race technical scrutineering. Please listen to the PA for further information.
