General Information

- This event is conducted under SRA rules.
- Paperwork can be collected at the Robinvale Community Centre between 1:30pm and 6pm Friday 11th March and will include competitor passes for entry into the event. **A fee will be charged at the gate to enter the start / finish area if no competitor passes are presented.**
- **If you break down it is vital you contact Race Safe on 1800 722 372.**
- There will be food and first aid available at the turnaround area. If first aid is required please contact an official for assistance.
- **There is to be no refuelling at the turn around area or between events in the Caravan Park.** Please carry enough fuel in the boat to complete the race. **NO REFUELLING IN THE WATER.**
- Entries will be seeded by the SRA seeding committee.
- Notification of race numbers will be emailed to the team captain.
- **All boats** are to complete a race day report within 1 hour of completion of racing on **each day** or face a \$200 fine and possible non acceptance of entry in the 2023 event.
- **Drivers, Observers and Skiers** will need to complete online briefing before attending the event – **NO ONLINE BRIEFING COMPLETED, NO RACING.**
- All Dash competitors must attend a Short Course Briefing on Saturday morning at 6.45 or 11.00 am at the Community Centre
- Any practice on the river will be before the weekend of racing and normal maritime laws will apply.
- **AS PER ROADS & MARITIME SERVICES NO BOATS ON THE RIVER AFTER 7PM**

- **All competitors and officials will be breathalysed at Robinvale Community Centre each day.**
Saturday morning - 6.30am to 8.00am
Saturday - 11.00am to 12.00 noon for afternoon racing.
Sunday - 7.00am to 8.30am
Photo ID must be produced at breath testing.

Superclass Shootout/Invitational

- The Superclass Shootout / Top 40 Dash (as per SRA Seeding Committee) will have **40 competitors.**
- Superclass will be run under SRA rules.
- The finishing order of the **Superclass Shootout / Top 40** will determine the start order for Sunday.
- Any Superclass boat failing to finish will start immediately behind the last finishing Superclass boat.

Junior Dash

- A Junior Dash will be run on Saturday following the Top 40 Dash and will involve teams of junior skiers (under 16 years) competing on the Superclass Shootout / Top 40 Dash course. This is a separate event so the team does not have to be the same as that competing in the Sunday event.
- Selection is at the discretion of the SRV Committee. If you are unsuccessful in your nomination your money will be refunded.

King of the Murray

The Robinvale Euston Ski Race is part of the Dennis Rowbottom King of the Murray Series which is conducted between River Classic events held in the same season. The events this season are Ted Hurley Classic, Southern 80, Robinvale Euston 80 and the Mildura 100.

To be eligible for the King of the Murray title, the team must compete in all four river classic events. A point score system will operate on the outright placings to determine the King of the Murray.
